In conclusion, this festival can bring people together and bring kindness and positivity.

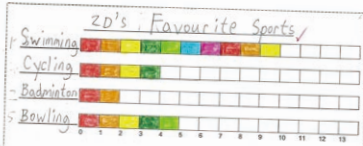

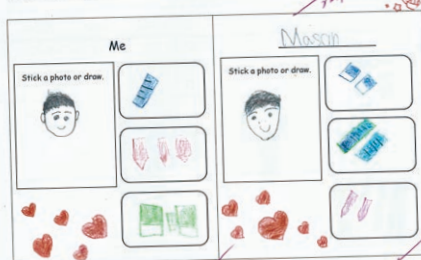

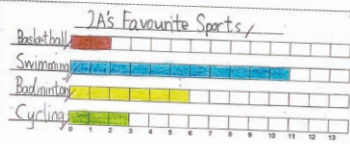
